City Council Update: Meter Pilot Phase II June 5, 2017

Phase II Parking Meter Pilot

- Phase I Smart Meter Pilot hosted in PARK Roanoke's off street lots in FY17
 - Outcomes-Improved utilization of the lots, payment methods and grew the parker base
- Phase II Smart Meter Pilot planned launch downtown this summer
- (7) Multispace smart meters to be tested
 - Meters provided by Parkeon Inc. no cost to the city
 - Solar powered Wi-Fi connected smart meters
 - Meters manage multiple spaces in each zone
 - Accept bank cards and US coins
 - Pay by phone capable

Phase II Pilot Team Recommendations

Pilot sites and zones: 100 block Salem Ave SE, Wall and Market St. around the Market Building, Market St. SE, Franklin Road SE



Phase II Meter Pilot

- ▶ 65 spaces <5% of on-street spaces in downtown core</p>
 - Pilot duration (90) days
 - Enforced Monday Friday 8am to 5 pm
 - Multi-space meters pay by plate
 - Paid parking increments-all parkers including handicapped tags and plate holders
 - First hour- FREE
 - Next hour- \$1.00
 - Next hour -\$3.00
 - Total hours in a Zone- 3 hours







Time Line and Next Steps

- June 19th City Council Approval for the meter pilot and amendments to City Code for the onstreet meter pilot
- June 20th- Public information / social media platform rollout begins
- July 15th or after-Install meters and pilot begins
 - On-site customer service ambassador program assists public in each meter zone
 - Public information / social media platforms continue

Time Line and Next Steps

- July October: Public feedback campaign
 - Various platforms to collect information and feedback
 - Gauge ease of use by the public
 - Reliability of the meter, mobile applications and Wi-Fi
 - Track use / turn over of metered blocks
 - Compile all feedback and comments
- November 6th or after –Report pilot results to City Council
